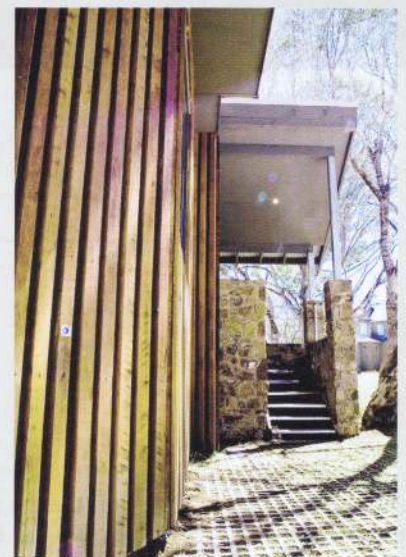

Located in the ski village of Dinner Plain, Mt Hotham, this luxurious alpine chalet was inspired by the natural colour palette of the surrounding mountains and snow gums. This chalet blends in perfectly with its natural surroundings and gives holidaymakers an experience they'll never forget. Built over three levels, the chalet's exterior is made up of stonework, corrugated iron, spotted gum timber panelling, shadow cladding, and is painted in tones complementing the landscape. Inside, pitched windows and natural colours evoke a warm, calm feeling. The wonderful views of the horizon can be seen through the double-glazed windows. The stylish kitchen has granite bench-tops and stainless-steel appliances. Other features include heated floors, panel heating, a double-sided fireplace, luxurious wool carpet in the bedrooms, polished timber staircases and large ceramic floor tiles throughout.

This gracious Victorian home in Kew received the quality makeover it deserved to bring it back to life. The brief was to transform the rear of the home's ghastly 1970s renovation and create a modern, contemporary kitchen, dining, living area and laundry. The open-plan living areas downstairs optimise space. A CBUS electrical system was installed offering fully automated and pre-programmable control of lights, music and heating on a central control panel. An archway at the top of the stairs marks the transition where the existing period home ends. The kitchen forms the central hub of the house, with white stone benchtops, glass splashbacks, designer tapware, walk-in pantry and twin ovens. Luxury bedrooms and bathrooms are located upstairs.
